Violence Free Business Project and Suffrage Day Memorial Service.

**AUCKLAND SOMALI COMMUNITY ASSN**

Raising awareness of family violence through a Somali community TV programme.

**CHINESE NEW SETTLERS TRUST, AUCKLAND**

Radio campaign in Cantonese and Mandarin.

**KA MAU TE WERO, GLEN INNES, AUCKLAND**

Marae workshops, promotions at markets, radio programmes, community conversations, exploration of family violence through art.

**NEW PLYMOUTH DISTRICT SAFER COMMUNITY COUNCIL**

12 month media campaign and events using local heroes to promote positive ways of being male.

**AHU WHAKATIKA CHALLENGE VIOLENCE TRUST, ROTORUA**

'Home Safe' community-wide campaign to support violence free families.

**TAUPO VIOLENCE INTERVENTION NETWORK**

Community road show developing resources, working with youth.

**WAIROA PRIMARY HEALTH CARE ORGANISATION**

Community awareness campaign to reduce family violence. Rahui on family violence promoted by Kaumatua promoting tikanga Maori models of working with family violence.

**AGE CONCERN WAIROA**

300 community members and kaumatua attended 'Breaking the Silence' community hui on elder abuse prevention.

**MANAWATU ABUSE INTERVENTION NETWORK (M.A.I.N), FEILDING**

Media campaign advertising campaign (including radio, posters in cinema washrooms), billboards, posters and other promotional materials.

**HOROWHENUA ABUSE LIAISON TEAM (HALT), LEVIN**

Community education and awareness raising campaign, involving local events, a media campaign and resource development.

**MARLBOROUGH VIOLENCE INTERVENTION NETWORK**

Ongoing campaign involving media, production of promotional material, seminar series, development of DVD and schools competition.

**GREYMOUTH & BULLER FAMILY VIOLENCE NETWORK GROUPS**

'Violence Free West Coast' campaign, incorporating a media campaign, development and distribution of resources and participation in key local events.

**WAKATIPU ABUSE PREVENTION NETWORK, QUEENSTOWN** Campaign and events to promote the whole community's responsibility in preventing family violence.

**TE WAI MATUA TRUST, DUNEDIN** 'Te Ao Marama - Moving into the Light' - an outdoor concert with a focus on family violence prevention in conjunction with White Ribbon Day.

**GORE COUNSELLING CENTRE** Community forums addressing roles that each of us can play in preventing family violence.

**INVERCARGILL FAMILY VIOLENCE FOCUS GROUP** Running a series of four expos in rural communities in Southland.

**TE AUPOURI MAORI TRUST BOARD, KAITIAIA** Promoting a violence free community in the Far North through a local media campaign.  
**WHARE TIMATANGA HOU ORA, KAITIAIA** Mana Wahine week - celebrating wahine.

**MEN AND FAMILY CENTRE SOUTH KAIPARA / HELENSVILLE WOMEN'S CENTRE, HELENSVILLE** Community campaign to change community attitudes to family violence through community hui and events.

**HAURAKI DOMESTIC VIOLENCE INTERVENTION NETWORK** Developing a plan to address family violence across the Hauraki region.

**HAMILTON ABUSE INTERVENTION PROJECT** "Hi Five to Hamilton" campaign promoting a positive, proactive community. Developing resources for refugee and migrant communities.

**PACIFIC PEOPLE'S ADDICTION SERVICES, HAMILTON** Community awareness raising activities with Pacific communities, churches, schools and sports groups.

**WHAKAATU WHANAUNGA TRUST, OPOTIKI** Media campaign to encourage attitudinal change to family violence and community events.

**TAIRAWHITI MEN AGAINST VIOLENCE, GISBORNE** Community media campaign encouraging men to stand up against violence.

**NAPIER WOMEN'S REFUGE INC**

Local media campaign, events and an expo to promote violence free message and services.

**FAMILY WORKS, HASTINGS** 'Building a Village' project: a neighbourhood project based in Camberley, Hastings, designed to build family and community connectedness and empowerment.

**TARARUA STRENGTHENING FAMILIES, DANNEVIRKE** 'Do the Right Thing for a Safe Tararua Free from Family and Community Violence' Campaign.

**MASTERTON SAFE AND HEALTHY COMMUNITY COUNCIL**

'Safe Circles' project, part of Violence Free Wairarapa campaign. Holding forums with groups of people in work and sports clubs settings to discuss violence, causes, effects, and what you can do to make a difference.

**WELLINGTON FAMILY VIOLENCE PREVENTION STEERING GROUP**

Media campaigns for Children's Day, Mothers' Day, Fathers' Day, White Ribbon Day. Static displays in shopping malls bookmark campaign. Encouraging employers to develop workplace policies for family violence.

**KAIKOURA FAMILY VIOLENCE NETWORK**

Campaign that includes community education, a seminar series, development and distribution of resources and a stall at the A&P show.

**WAIMAKARIRI FAMILY VIOLENCE NETWORK, RANGIORA**

Local media campaign, involving development and distribution of resources, convening meetings, forums and workshops, participation in community events, working with media.
